FR. LON KONOLD, O.M.I., CELEBRATES 40 YEARS OF PRIESTHOOD

On Friday evening, June 10, 1977, at 7:30 p.m., I was ordained to the priesthood by Bishop John Kinney in my home parish of St. Thomas the Apostle in South Minneapolis. How can it be 40 years ago already? During this time I have ministered in Norway, Denmark, and the United States in that order. There have been so many graces, blessings, and extraordinary opportunities that have come my way in these past 40 years. So many wonderful people have contributed to make this possible. I hope and pray that God has found me to be a good and

faithful servant in spite of my many faults and shortcomings.

My priestly calling is within the context of my other calling – vowed religious life as a Missionary Oblate of Mary Immaculate (O.M.I.). I have been an Oblate since August 15, 1971, when I took my first vows.

Because I began my ministry in Scandinavia, to serve in a totally secular culture is foundational to my priestly life. Secularity is not necessarily a negative thing; it provides a great opportunity for ongoing conversion which we are all called to. I can recognize

people's spiritual hunger, which is not always met by religion as they know it – a situation similar to St. Eugene's.

All of us are called to be ministers, each in our own way, by virtue of our baptism. "The gifts we have, we are given to share." Together we work to cooperate with Christ to actualize His Kingdom among us, especially for those who feel lost and/or abandoned.


