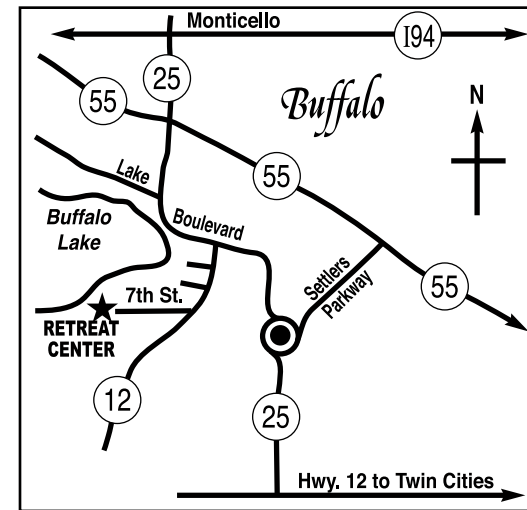

## Rentals

Christ the King Retreat facilities are open to not-for-profit groups and organizations.

There are 132 sleeping accommodations (63 double rooms; 6 single), complete with meeting and dining rooms, small group rooms, two large conference rooms, a spacious chapel, and beautiful grounds.

Rentals average \$120.00 per person per day. This includes 3 meals, room, conference hall, and snack bar. Audio-visual equipment is available at a nominal fee.
